KEOKUK BARGE COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES  
Tuesday, August 7th 2018  
3:45 P.M.

Meeting called to order at 3:55 by Tonya Boltz.

In attendance: Tonya Boltz, Pam Horner, Roger Houston and Doug Matlick. Others present: Cole O'Donnell, Martin, Charlie and Terry from Poepping, Stone, Bach and Assoc.

Motion to approve minutes from July 17, 2018 Barge Commission meeting was made by Doug Ewing. Second by Roger Houston.

Absent: Ryan Uhlmeier, Doug Ewing and Angela Profeta.

Introductions were made with committee and the group from Poepping, Stone, Bach & Assoc.

Discussion began with the Engineering companies presentation of the preliminary estimate of cost to repair the barge. Terry Knoke first went over the estimated cost for the civil part of the budget. This involved the mobilization of the barge, ramps, electric, water, sewer service and the land area. Martin Meyer then discussed the architectural part of the budget. This involved the inside of the barge with the existing kitchens, retail area, existing toilet rooms, common space, proposed bed & breakfast and misc. repairs.

They were ready to start the architectural drawings as soon as we gave them the ok. We discussed the information and asked them to revise the cost for just the mobilization, relocation of the barge, ramps and the utilities. The firm is going to do a revised estimate of cost. When this information is received Cole will present it to the city council.

We discussed the clean-up of the barge and Cole mentioned this has been done. Joyce Glasscock will clean tables and areas they will use for the tour on August 17, 2018.
