Motion made by Bryant second by Garcia to approve initial reading amending the zoning ordinance of the City of Keokuk, Lee County, Iowa by rezoning lots 7, 8 and 9 in the original City of Keokuk from R-3, two family dwelling districts to a M-1, light industrial district.

Motion made by Bryant, second by Crenshaw to waive the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of the ordinance.

Roll Call Vote: AYES – Crenshaw, Andrews, Tillman and Bryant. NAYS - Garcia, Oltmans, and Greenwald. (4) AYES, (3) NAYS, (2) ABSENT. Motion failed.

Motion made by Oltmans, second Garcia to approve third reading of an Ordinance amending Chapters 13.04, 13.08, 13.10, and 13.14 Sewer Regulations of the Keokuk Municipal Code. No roll call vote taken.

Motion made by Garcia, second by Oltmans to approve the following proposed **RESOLUTION NO. 236-2023:** "A RESOLUTION APPROVING A DEMO CONTRACT FOR PROPERTY AT 720 MORGAN STREET, 1002 CONCERT STREET AND 1222 BANK STREET." (7) AYES, (0) NAYS. Motion carried.

Greenwald requested to reconsider Sewer Regulation Ordinance for a roll call vote.
